

Del Campo Peak (6613') – south route and Gothic Peak (6213')
Sept 29-30 (Sat-Sun)

Both summits are located in the Monte Cristo area southwest of Glacier peak with the Barlow pass trailhead (2400') about 1 – ½ hours from Seattle. It's only about 5 miles along the steep Weeden Creek trail to camp in magnificent Gothic basin at Foggy Lake (5300'), from where both peaks are easily climbed. The class 3/4 scrambles are short as both Del Campo and Gothic are overlooking the lake. The only gear required is a helmet.

I've done these both 2X previously. Folks are welcome to spend the night here in Seattle on the Friday evening.
