Craig Blanton called the meeting called to order at 6:30 pm.

**Rick Cooper, Backpacking Chair**, presented an overview of the club's backpacking activities. He reports always looking for more backpack leaders. If interested, please contact Rick Cooper. Backpack activities include a potluck, Beginners Backpack class, Beginners Backpack trip and 15 or so different backpack trips throughout the year.

**Rob Kimmich, Technology Committee Chair**, along with John Balling, presented a proposal to Council. They propose the Chemeketan's change how they handle their technology, moving from the all-volunteer-run system used since the early 2000's to one that can better manage the increased technological of the club, run by professionals. John and Rob suggest we shift and hire a vendor to bring the club website and database up to date and manage the tech needs on an ongoing basis with a club member overseeing the process. Rob and John estimate a range of \$4,000-\$10,000 in initial set up fees and several hundred to a thousand dollars in annual maintenance fees. Rob and John are still gathering info.

Ann Hanus moved that the council authorize Rob Kimmich and John Balling to develop a detailed proposal for recreating the website and database with costs included for set-up and maintenance. Ralph Hall seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously. John and Rob will be back in July with the proposal.

**Carl Anderson** spoke about attracting more families to join the Chemeketan's and creating more family friendly events. He suggested having a booth at The Awesome 3000 race or other similar events where families congregate. Carl agreed to put a message in the Chemeketan Bulletin asking for interest in family friendly club activities. He will report back to the council on his progress.

**The June Agenda** was adopted with 4 additions made: Chemeketan Council making donation policy; Summer Council Schedule; Restriction of Trail Access; Property Taxes.

# **May 2017 Treasurer Activities (Information Only)**

2015 and 2016 Federal and Oregon tax forms were mailed on May 4, 2017. All 4 tax payment checks were processed at Pioneer bank on May 10, 2017.

The 501(c)(7) tax-exempt status reinstatement request package preparation was completed on May 24, 2017. The reinstatement request requires payment of an \$850 fee to the IRS. The package will be mailed to the IRS on June 12, assuming council approval of the fee payment at the June 7 council meeting.

Oregon Division of State Lands (DSL) has an online tool for searching for unclaimed property. A search found that "Chemeketans Outdoor" has unclaimed property dating to 2007. I submitted a claim for the property on behalf of Chemeketans on May 25, 2017.

Craig Blanton moved to approve the expenses. Bruce Patterson seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.
