

TRAIL MAINTENANCE

1. No activity should be scheduled on National Trails Day.
2. Anyone operating a chainsaw on a Chemeketan sponsored trail maintenance activity is required to wear standard safety gear and follow safety standards as established by the Forest Service.
3. Drivers may be reimbursed for mileage at a rate established by Executive Council (currently 35 cents per mile).

ALL TRIPS

4. Leaders are expected to follow guidelines listed in the Leaders Guide.
5. Each activity Committee will define its own leader qualifications.
6. Registration must be with the leader, not a third party.
7. Outdoor activities led by a Club member but not listed in the Bulletin or other means of all member notification will not be accepted as qualifying for membership.
8. Dogs/pets or service animals are not allowed on trips.
9. Drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or firearms are not allowed on outdoor trips.
10. All participants are responsible to determine from the description of distance, altitude, terrain, trail and possible weather conditions whether they, their children and guests can fully participate.
11. The leader may refuse to take anyone not properly equipped or whose skill and conditioning do not meet length and difficulty of a specific trip.
12. Essentials must be carried (list available in the Bulletin).
13. All trips should include at least three participants for safety reasons.
14. A guest under 18 years of age must provide a signed **RELEASE FROM LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK** to the trip leader if he/she is not accompanied by a parent or guardian.
